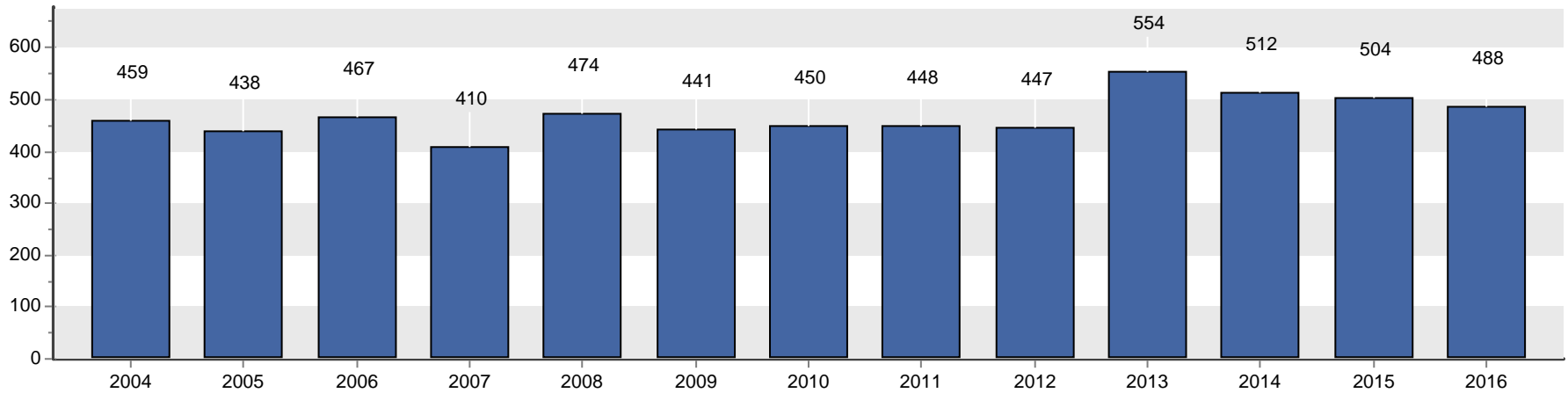

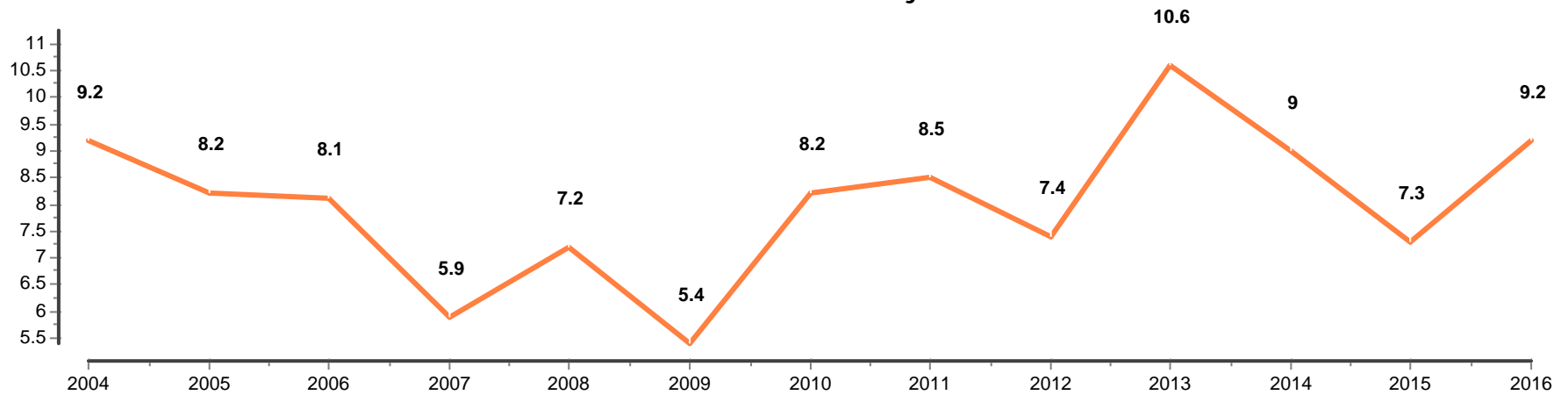

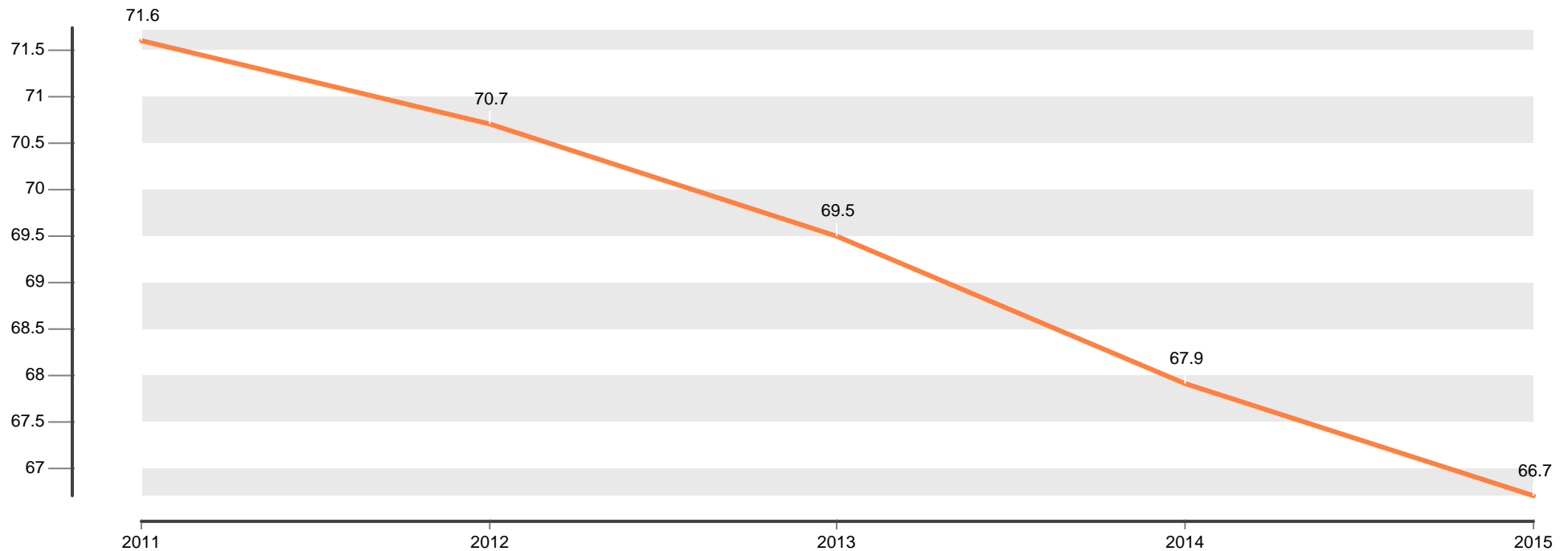

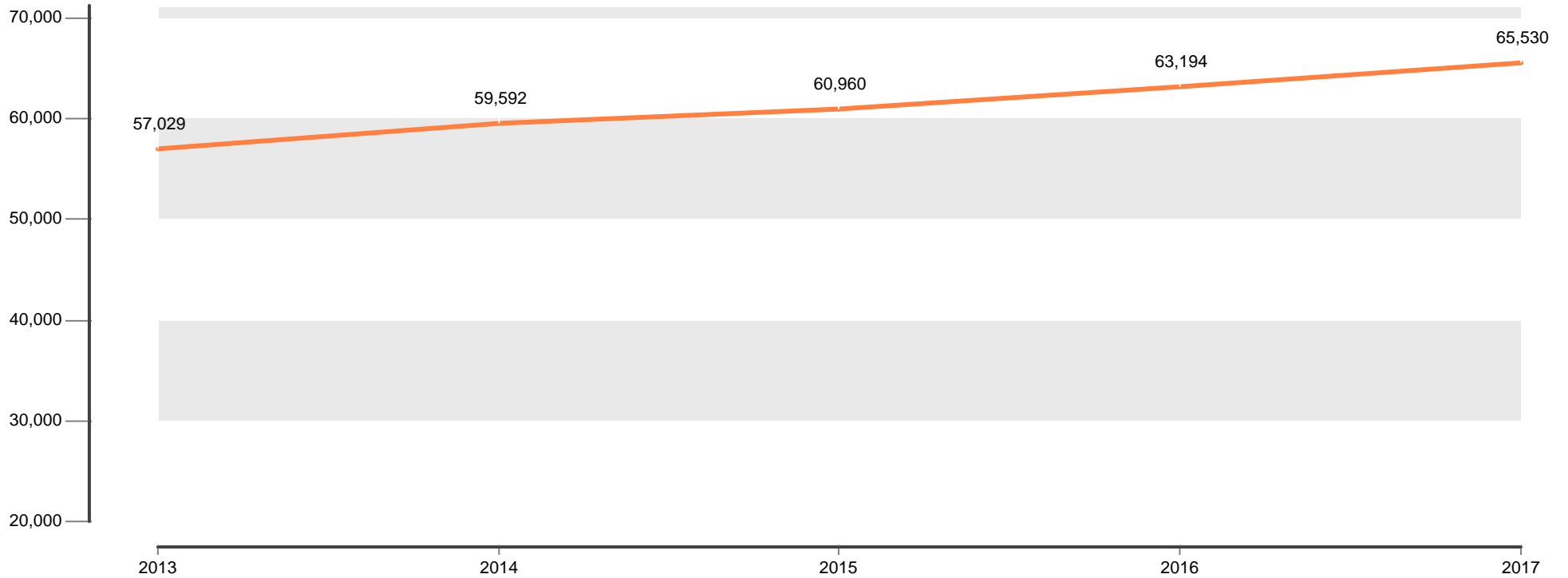
### Percent Receiving an Institutional Grant

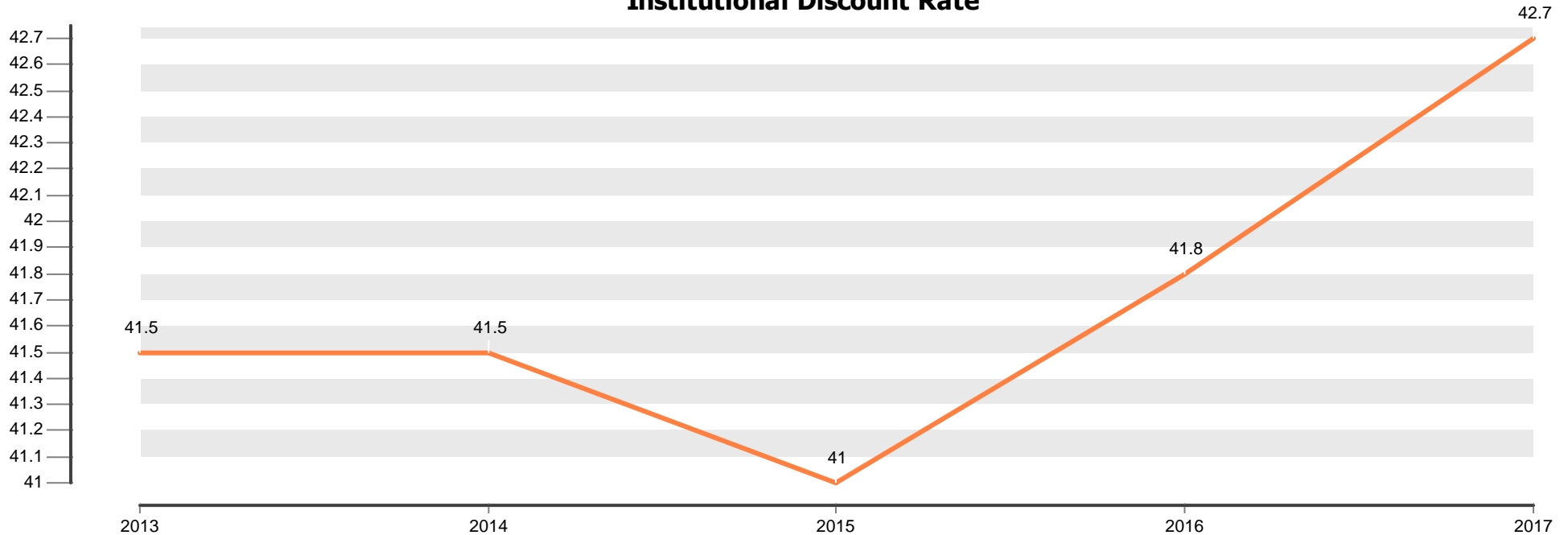

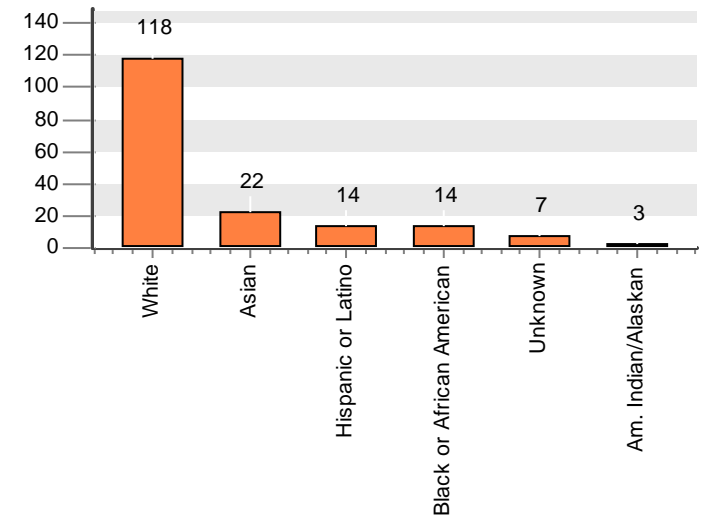

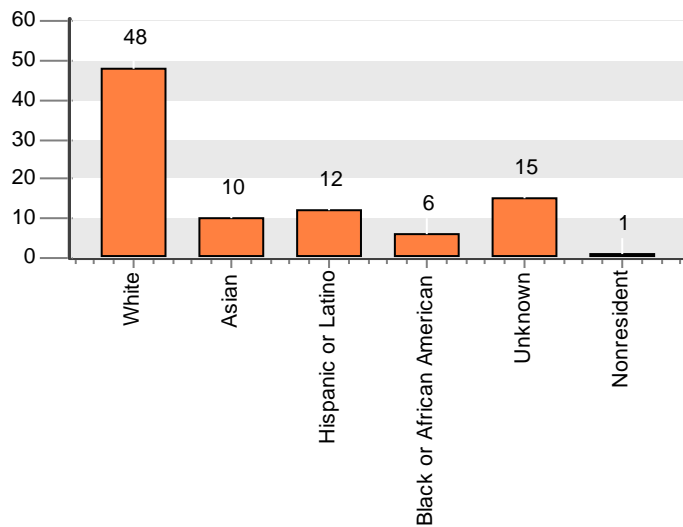
