## HONORIS CAUSA

**Namandjé Ne’fertiti Bumpus ’03** is chief scientific and innovation officer at Charles River Laboratories, where she leads the company’s scientific strategy, oversees its research and development portfolio, and advances innovation in nonclinical science. She also is a venture partner at F-Prime Capital and is a member of the Board of Directors of Recursion Pharmaceuticals. Previously, she served as the Food and Drug Administration’s principal deputy commissioner and chief scientist from 2022 to 2024. Prior to joining the FDA, she was the E.K. Marshall and Thomas H. Maren Professor and chair of the Department of Pharmacology and Molecular Sciences at the Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine, where she also served as associate dean for basic research. Her research has focused on drug metabolism, pharmacogenetics, bioanalytical chemistry, and infectious disease pharmacology. She earned a B.A. in biology from Occidental, a Ph.D. in pharmacology from the University of Michigan, and completed a postdoctoral fellowship in molecular and experimental medicine at the Scripps Research Institute. Her honors include the Presidential Early Career Award for Scientists and Engineers, and she is an elected fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science. Bumpus is a past president of the American Society for Pharmacology and Experimental Therapeutics, and she also previously chaired the NIH Xenobiotic and Nutrient Disposition and Action Study Section. She has served on the Occidental College Board of Trustees and will rejoin the Board in July.

**Mike Curb** is founder and chairman of Curb Records and president of the Mike Curb Foundation, which has contributed more than \$200 million to education, historic preservation, homelessness, and related causes. A Grammy Award winner with a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame, Curb has written or co-written more than 400 songs and composed or supervised more than 50 film soundtracks, including contributions to *Dirty Dancing* and *Inglourious Basterds*. He has also established and endowed academic programs and institutes at numerous universities, including the Mike Curb College of Entertainment and Business at Belmont University and the Mike Curb College of Arts, Media, and Communication at California State University, Northridge, his alma mater. Curb served as the 42nd lieutenant governor of California under Governor Jerry Brown and later chaired the Republican National Finance Committee at President Ronald Reagan’s request. He also worked alongside San Francisco Supervisor Harvey Milk to defeat the Briggs Initiative in 1978. As co-owner of Curb Agajanian Performance Group, Curb has sponsored race cars in NASCAR, IndyCar, and other series for more than 40 years, earning recognition from the Indianapolis Motor Speedway in 2020 for his contributions to motorsports.

**Gloria Duffy ’75** is co-president, co-chief executive officer, and a member of the Board of Governors of the San Francisco-based Commonwealth Club of California, the nation’s largest and oldest public affairs forum. She is an expert on national security issues and served as commissioner of the 2022-23 Congressional Strategic Posture Commission. She also is principal of Duffy Investments. As deputy assistant secretary of defense under President Bill Clinton, Duffy worked with countries to dismantle their weapons of mass destruction. She currently serves as a senior fellow for the American Leadership Forum Silicon Valley and organizer for the California Elder Justice Task Force. Duffy previously served on a number of boards related to health, public policy, education, and social causes, and was a member of the Occidental College Board of Trustees for nearly 20 years and was elected to emeritus trustee status in 2025. She graduated magna cum laude with a degree in interdisciplinary studies from Occidental and went on to receive an M.A., M.Phil., and Ph.D. in political science from Columbia University. Duffy was awarded an honorary degree from the University of San Francisco in 2006.

**Anna Malaika Tubbs** is a leading expert on race, gender, and equity. She holds a Ph.D. in sociology and a master’s degree in multidisciplinary gender studies from the University of Cambridge, as well as a bachelor’s degree in medical anthropology from Stanford University. Her work bridges academic research and public scholarship, translating complex ideas into clear, engaging stories for broad audiences. Tubbs has written two books, both *New York Times* bestsellers. *The Three Mothers: How the Mothers of Martin Luther King, Jr., Malcolm X, and James Baldwin Shaped a Nation*, was published in 2021 and was widely recognized as one of the year’s most influential works. Her second book, *Erased: What American Patriarchy Has Hidden From Us*, was published in May 2025 and examines how the hierarchical system the Founding Fathers designed continues to impact our daily lives. Her writing has appeared in *Time*, *New York* magazine, *Newsweek*, *The Guardian*, and other major outlets, and her 2021 TED Talk, “How Moms Shape the World,” has amassed more than 2.1 million views.
