HONORIS CAUSA

JOSEPH HAIRSTON DUFF '68

A political science major at Occidental, Joe Duff '68 was awarded the Rockefeller Foundation Scholarship as a first-year. He played football with the Tigers for three years and helped organize the College's first Black Student Caucus. Additionally, he took part in Oxy's urban studies and pre-law curriculum and its two-year Air Force ROTC program, graduating with an Air Force Reserve second lieutenant commission.

Duff earned his juris doctor degree from the UCLA School of Law, after which he served four years in the Air Force Judge Advocate General Corps. He then entered private practice in his own firm and became a prominent civil rights attorney, focusing on the efficacy of racial and ethnic affirmative action in education and law. He served as a leader of the NAACP Los Angeles Branch, worked as a legal adviser to the Charles R. Drew University of Medicine and Science, and was senior staff counsel for the California Department of Fair Employment and Housing. Duff closed his legal career while serving as senior counsel and interim general counsel for the NAACP Legal Defense and Educational Fund, the historic and premier law firm on issues of racial justice.

Along with his wife, trustee emerita Alice Walker Duff '69 H'02, he continues to be active in Occidental's Black Alumni Organization. Together, the Duffs received the Occidental College Alumni Seal Award for public service in 1992.

EDWARD JOSEPH RUSCHA IV

Ed Ruscha was born in 1937 in Omaha, Nebraska, and grew up in Oklahoma City. In 1956, he took Route 66 to California, which would become a central part of his story as an artist. Settling in Los Angeles, he studied art at Chouinard Art Institute (now California Institute of the Arts) and had an early job as a commercial illustrator. In the 1960s, inspired by artists such as Raymond Hains, René Magritte, Jasper Johns, and Kurt Schwitters, Ruscha became a vibrant part of the art scene surrounding Ferus Gallery in Los Angeles.

Ruscha has been living and working in the L.A. area for more than 60 years. Through his innovative approach to painting, drawing, and photography, Ruscha has influenced artists worldwide and is considered to be one of the most important figures in contemporary art today. In early photographic work, Ruscha created documentary images and books full of swimming pools, parking lots, buildings on Sunset Boulevard, gas stations, and many other features of L.A. life. In his paintings and drawings, these same subjects combine with language to poetically evoke the changing fabric of the city through themes of evolution and destruction.

Ruscha's work was the subject of *ED RUSCHA / NOW THEN*, a recent retrospective at the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) in New York City; the exhibition opened at the Los Angeles County Museum of Art (LACMA) on April 7 and will run through October 6.

LINDY LAUREN WEST '04

Lindy West '04 is an author, producer, and podcaster who writes comedy, memoir, and political analysis. Her writing career at Gawker Media's feminist website, *Jezebel*, established her as an influential voice in the chaotic online media boom of the early 2010s. Her work has also appeared in *This American Life*, *The New York Times*, *The Guardian*, *Cosmopolitan*, *GQ*, *Vulture*, and elsewhere. She is the co-founder of the reproductive rights destigmatization campaign #ShoutYourAbortion.

West graduated from Occidental with honors in English and comparative literary studies. She sang in the Glee Club for two years, wrote occasionally for the *Occidental Weekly*, had a short-lived campus radio show on KOXY, and studied abroad in Brighton, U.K. West credits her Occidental education with her feminist awakening, her commitment to justice, her confidence as a writer, and her deep love of Los Angeles.

In 2016, West published her first book, the memoir *Shrill: Notes From a Loud Woman*, which became a *New York Times* bestseller and was adapted into the Hulu series of the same name starring *Saturday Night Live*'s Aidy Bryant, on which West served as executive producer for three seasons. West has since published two other books of essays and is working on her fourth book, a follow-up to *Shrill* titled *Adult Braces*, which will be out in 2025.

West currently co-hosts the weekly comedy podcast *Text Me Back*. She co-wrote and produced the independent feature film *Thin Skin*, which was released in 2023. She lives in the woods in rural Washington state with her two partners and their huge dog, Barry.
