Position Description:

The [Neighborhood Partnership Program](#) was created as a response to the strong need for supportive programming in the Los Angeles inner-city that serves underrepresented youth of color in attaining postsecondary degrees. As part of the services we offer, tours are student-led and focus on helping K-12 students better understand college as a whole. College Ambassadors will serve as Oxy Tour Guides and take part in Student Panels during Look at College Days, or when requested by NPP and community partners.

***Our priority is the health and safety of all students and staff. If and when it is safe to do so, we will be ready to deliver our services in-person. As of now for the 2021 fall semester, NPP will deliver services virtually.**

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Work in teams to facilitate and lead Oxy Tours and/or Student Information Panels for middle school and high school students.
- Student Panels will focus on helping students better understand college, the college application process, and the private liberal arts education.
- Attend planning meetings, trainings, and curriculum development meetings with NPP staff and other Student Dialogue Facilitators

Position Requirements/Preferences:

- Experience working with and building community with marginalized youth, including low income students, first-generation college students, BIPOC students, immigrant students, etc.
- Knowledge of Occidental Campus, college life, and ability to speak on college experience
- Strong public speaking skills
- Ability to take initiative and work both independently and on a team
- Students who have previously worked with NPP are highly encouraged to apply
