Job Summary

The Campus Dining Sustainability Research and Implementation Intern is a key student intern position in the college's sustainability commitments. The intern works with students and staff to assist Campus Dining's in their commitment to waste diversion, and ethical and sustainable food purchasing. Applicants must be reliable, hardworking, creative, and passionate about making a difference on campus. Reports to the Assistant Vice President of Hospitality Services.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Uses a variety of research methods to analyze, report, and provide recommendations for Campus Dining's sustainability projects and programs.
- Aids in maintaining the Real Food Challenge Database consisting of detailed spreadsheet work and researches sources of sustainable food.
- Aids in researching comparable institutions' sustainable food programs
- Ensures proper sustainability benchmarks are established and maintained.
- Reviews current environmental laws and regulations to determine compliance requirements.
- Plans, designs and implements programs to promote sustainability within the campus community.
- Assists with designing Food Justice Month and Earth Day programming.
- Perform general office duties as needed.
