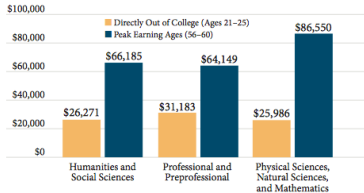
HOW LIBERAL ARTS STACK UP

93% of employers say they want employees who can think critically and communicate effectively (AAC&U report)

3/4 of employers prefer applicants with knowledge of global issues and cultures

45% of activities people are paid for may be automated in the future. Complex skills taught in liberal arts, like critical thinking, managing, and teaching are far less likely to be automated (McKinsey & Company study)

Liberal Arts majors tend to make more than their peers with pre/professional degrees (chart from AAC&U report)
