

ONE POINT PERSPECTIVE LANDSCAPE PAINTING

INTRODUCTION

Create a watercolor landscape painting using one point perspective!



MATERIALS

- Watercolor Paper
- Watercolor Brushes
- Watercolor paints
- Pencil
- Black sharpie or pen
- Water cup
- Paper Towels

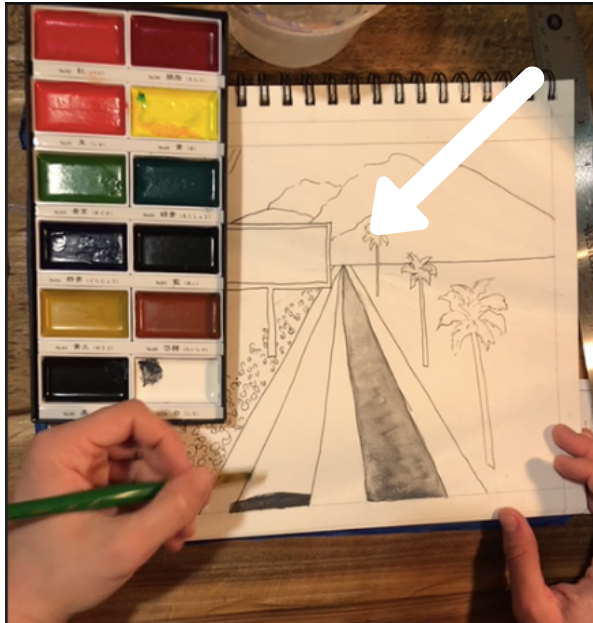
STEPS

1

Draw a line in pencil across your page horizontally - this is your horizon line.

2

Draw two diagonal lines from the horizon line to the edge of the paper to create a road or pathway.



The spot where your lines meet on the horizon line is called your vanishing point!

3

Add in any plants, buildings or people that live in your landscape!

4

Outline your lines in sharpie or pen.

5

Using your watercolors, fill in your background and big shapes first. Fill in your smaller shapes and experiment with layering colors!
